

“French as a Foreign Language” Class Program

DELFD/DALF Preparation Classes

Student profile: DELF/DALF preparation classes are for adult students who want to study for the DELF/DALF exams.

Hours: 8 total hours

Duration: 2 weeks

Class size: 14 students maximum per class

Pre-requisites: Take the placement test in order to determine with DELF/DALF level to study

Learning objectives: Prepare students to take the DELF/DALF exams.

Methodological approach

Our teaching is based on a communicative method based on active participation of the learners (work in small groups, role-playing, etc.). Our teachers use recent DELF/DALF manuals, mock exams and the published content of previous years' exams.

Contents:

Week 1: Getting prepared

- Presentation of the exam
- Nature of the test, required know-how and subjects
- Methodological tips

Week 2: Practice

- Training sessions for the 4 skills (oral comprehension, written comprehension, written production, oral production)
- Examples for the 4 competencies
- Self-evaluation

Course materials and activities

The manual used during the classes is: *Réussir le DELF A1/A2*, *Réussir le DELF B1/B2* or *Réussir le DALF C1/C2* according to the class level (Editions Didier).

Evaluation

- Attendance at classes is required. We recommend active participation during classes.
- Students' skills are assessed during in-class activities
